Go Away in May?



Coronado Islands

Great Yellowtail fishing yesterday. The Mission Belle was just 1 fish short of limits for all on board. They got 49 yellows for 10 guys.

The Yellows continue to be mixed in size, although most were 15lbers.

The fish were scattered all over the Islands under spots of birds. A fly lined Sardine was the hot bait yesterday with a few more on Surface Iron and Yoyo Jigs.

The bite has been an afternoon affair but it got started earlier yesterday at around 10am. So far as of 10 am a few Yellows have been caught, but no big stops yet.... This could change at any moment. Watch for updates. Barracuda are due at any time now. They have a history of showing up right at the Day of the Docks time of April.

They are often found on the TJ Flats early in the year and on the Ribbon kelp for most of the season. Watch for the big bird schools.

At 11:00am the Long Range Boat American Angler is on a rare overnight trip to the Coronados and they say they have 12 Yellows on the deck


At least the Padres have started Wednesday night fight night. It is between the sixth and seventh inning, right before they shut down beer sales.






