War Drums Beat! Debt Ceiling Nears...

The stock market reminded us once again that markets can get rattled from time to time. The Dow ended the day on Tuesday with a 170 point drop. A combination of three headwinds all hit the market at the same time. Here is what Tuesday's terrible trifecta consisted of:

- 1. We are now down to just two months before the next debt ceiling. You didn't think that America would get its financial house in order by then, did you? It will be necessary to go to the bank once again to get our credit limit raised.
 - The last time this happened, it got very ugly. Why should it be any different this time?
- 2. Taper talk continues to be the middle part of this troublesome threesome that has got the market all in a tizzy once again. Will he or won't he? He will. When will he? Nobody knows-it depends upon the economy.
- 3. If that double-barreled shotgun was not enough of a hit on Tuesday's market, Secretary of State, John Kerry took center stage with proof that Bashar-al Assad, president of Syria, was the one behind the chemical attacks that killed over 1,000 Syrians.

Throwing in the threat of some kind of attack on Syria really put the market in a tailspin. It also sent oil prices soaring! Here is a current chart of the Dow.



For the second time in three months, the market is once again in correction mode. So far, the Dow is down about 5.3% from the top. The market is also giving another short-term technical sell signal. As you can see from the above chart, the 20 day moving average of the Dow is crossing below the 50 day moving average.

The Dow is also fast approaching its recent support level of 14,551. An attack on Syria could quickly put the Dow below this key support level. The next level of support would be down around the 200 day moving average, which currently sits at about 14,400. A violation of these support levels would not be good for equities.

Before we panic, let's first look at the some more indexes. Here is a current 1-yr chart of the S&P 500.



The chart of the S&P 500 looks a lot healthier, but it would not take much to cause the same short-term technical sell signal that the Dow is now flashing.

Let's next look at the NASDAQ:



The NASDAQ still looks very healthy for now, but it too needs to be watched very closely going forward. It would not take much to tip it.

Earnings season is now behind us. Summer is turning into fall. The wind at our back seems to be dissipating. We are now starting to feel some headwinds kick up in the market. Before we stick a fork into this current rally however, let's gather some more facts.



With CNBC's ratings plunging the way they have been recently, he may be right!

When uncertainty enters into the picture, stocks and risk in general become less desirable. That is what we are seeing in the market right now. As recently as Thursday however, there have been a lot of individual stocks breaking out to new highs. It is not time to flee for the exits just yet.

Oil prices, along with oil stocks continue to climb as do many biotechs. Here is a chart of oil.




Up, up and away!

Most of the time, some of the best clues come from the current ranking of the asset classes. Here are my current top ranked asset classes amongst the 45 that I track:



On a relative basis, small cap domestic stocks are STILL the leading asset class in the market. They are starting to show some signs of weakness, however. Mid and Large cap stocks are dropping down into the neutral area of the leaderboard, while silver has now jumped all the way up to third place.


Where did those mid and large cap stock asset classes go?



Way down to the second tier of the leader board, where I have no interest. That is not to say that ALL mid and large cap stocks are falling from grace, however. Many are still holding up well, but these are two asset classes that are dropping fast, however.

At the same time, commodities and cash are climbing their way up the ladder.

Being short the market has finally moved out of last place, but it has only moved up to forty-fourth place, however. It is not too soon to start thinking about hedging portfolios though. **What if** Syria really does begin to escalate?

There are a lot of major countries like Russia, Iran, Israel, etc. who could easily get involved. No wonder oil prices are spiking!

Real estate stocks, mortgage REIT(s), and emerging markets continue to terrible places to have money parked.

Notice the big drop in the S&P 500 ETF over the last 30 days. This is more evidence that stocks are becoming less and less desirable as of now. If nothing happens in Syria then this all may be a moot point. We do still have the debt ceiling debate and Fed taper to worry about, however.


